Now we're always hearing about road accidents, and when we're in a car we try to drive carefully, but how many of us take the same degree of care in our homes? Any large hospital will tell you the number of accidents that happen in the home is almost the same as those on the road. I don't pretend to be an expert, but I've thought a lot about how and why these accidents happen and what we can do to prevent them.

One of the commonest and most dangerous causes of home accidents is wrong and careless use of electrical equipment. People will continue to use a loose plug or pull out a plug without first turning off the power. In spite of warning, one will carry an electric heater into the bathroom when he is going to have a bath. Sometimes one forgets to cut off the power before mending a lamp or something else. All these will cause accidents. So the rule about anything that works by electricity is: Switch off before you touch anything and don't pretend you know when you actually don't.

If you've got children in the house, it's always best to keep medicines of any kind out of their reach. Otherwise, they may be taken for candies or a new kind of drink. When there are older people living with you, you have to take particular care in a number of ways in order to make them safe and happy.

Fire, of course, is always a risk. So remember not to dry clothes in front of fires, or leave stoves in the middle of rooms where they can easily be knocked over. And don't forget to keep the children away from fire. Smoking, too, may cause fire. So you'd better give it up.

Safety may mean a little more time and care, but it may save you a lot of trouble.

There is a place on our earth where hot water and stream come up from under the ground. It is a large island in the Pacific Ocean. The island is North Island in New Zealand.

The planet on which we live is a ball of very hot rock. It is a good thing for us that the outside shell(壳) is cold. If it were hot, no one could live here. If our earth were only as big as an egg, then the outside part would be as deep as the egg's shell.

The earth's shell has cracks in it in some places. In New Zealand this shell seems to have more cracks than in other places in the earth. There are spots where the ground is so hot that it burns the bottom of your shoes. In some places, hot water shoots into the air **from time to time**. At other points, you can see steam coming up from pools of hot water.

The people who live in these places make use of the heat coming from inside the earth. Some of them cook in the hot pools. They put food into a basket and place it in the water. Washing clothes is done in the same way.

Many people bring the hot water from below the earth into their home. They do this by putting a pipe(管子) a hundred feet or more into the ground. In this way they get hot water and steam for cooking and washing, and for heating their homes.

The friendship between humans and dogs possibly began 14, 000 years ago. Here are four examples of "a dog's life" in the human world today.

Treated like a queen.

Tiffany is one of these dogs. Her owner, Nancy Iane Loewy, treats her like a queen. She patiently prepares Tiffany's meals of meat, fish, chicken and different kinds of fresh vegetables. Tiffany also eats yoghurt and biscuits after dinner. Loewy's husband has a very good job and her two sons are away at university, so she has the time and money to treat Tiffany very well, and she truly enjoys doing it. "I want to give her the healthiest, most wonderful life as long as possible," she says.

Food sniffer dogs (嗅探犬)

Food sniffer dogs work at international airports in the United States. Their job is to smell and find illegal (不合法的) fruits, vegetables and other foods in bags and mail. These foods sometimes bring insects and diseases which could be dangerous for plants and animals. The dog calmly sits down next to anything that smells suspicious (可疑的). The dog's human partner then

checks for illegal foods. Sniffer dogs are friendly and cute, so they don't scare people as they sniff through the crowds. More importantly, these dogs have an astonishing nose for food. They can find food in bags 84% of the time.

Animal carers

Jessie is a whippet (水灵狗) that visits very sick children in hospital. She shows them her love and when they feel down, Jessie makes them happy. Jessie helps patients to stay strong during their time in hospital.

There are many different kinds of animals that help people. We train "service dogs" to help people with physical disabilities. The best known service dogs are guides for the blind. But they can also learn to _____, turn lights on and off, pick up objects from the floor and even pull wheelchairs.
